



HEALTH TESTING NECESSARY FOR PROPER PATIENT CARE

Dr. Love is proud to offer retinal photography, blood sugar screening, and blood pressure screening in addition to the basic eye examination. In order to provide preventative eye health evaluations and preserve your sight by early detection of systemic (body) disease and eye disease, Dr. Love recommends these three necessary health test on all patients annually. Your vision insurance **ONLY** covers a basic eye examination. Since your vision insurance **DOES NOT** cover the cost of these very important vital tests, Clermont Family Eyecare is offering **ALL** three health tests to you at a reduced fee of \$35.00:

- 1. RETINAL PHOTOGRAPHY** - The digital retinal imaging system takes images of the retina (the back part of your eye) which is much like a dentist x-raying your mouth annually. The retinal photos document the internal health of your eyes and allow for accurate yearly comparisons. This enables the doctor in early detection and follow-up care of many disorders including glaucoma, diabetic eye disease, macular degeneration, and other vision threatening conditions in order to preserve your sight. The fee is \$39.00.
- 2. BLOOD SUGAR SCREENING** - Diabetes is the number one (leading) cause of blindness in the United States. If we do not test your blood sugar yearly, I have no way of knowing if you have this dangerous condition until you begin to have sight related problems which is at the very late stage of diabetes. The fee is \$10.00.
- 3. BLOOD PRESSURE SCREENING** - Hypertension is the second (2nd) leading cause of blindness in the country. If you do not have this evaluated on each vision examination, you are taking a great risk. High blood pressure is called the "SILENT KILLER" and can affect anyone at any age. The fee is \$10.00.

Dilation

Dilation is included with your comprehensive eye examination for NO ADDITIONAL FEE. Dr. Love recommends that you get your eyes dilated once a year, especially if you have any medical conditions, such as, diabetes, blood pressure, thyroid, arthritis, etc. In order to dilate your eyes, the doctor is going to put some medication in your eyes. The medication will make your pupils big so that the doctor can examine the inside of your eyes for any eye conditions like **glaucoma, cataracts, macular degeneration, and retinal diseases related to diabetes, blood pressure, etc.** The drops will take 10 – 15 minutes to take effect. Side effects include dilated pupil, blurry vision up close, and sensitivity to bright lights which can last at least 3-4 hours, and in rare cases up to 24 hours. The importance of the dilation is that without it, the doctor cannot completely **check the health** of the back of the eyes.
